**2009 New Jersey State Outdoor Pistol
Championship – 9/26 to 10/4**

Congratulations to OBRPC Bullseye shooters who joined 116 competitors from 9 states participating in the 2009 NJ Outdoor State Pistol Championship held at CJRPC in Jackson.

Kimberly Hullings repeated High Resident Junior honors with her debut in Sharpshooter class! She fired a "personal best" 778-17X in centerfire! **Kevin Ball** had an open win 198-9X topping all other 115 match competitors in centerfire rapid fire, and was High NJ Resident Senior with 2566-84X.

Along with **John Gemmill**, Kevin made the 2009 NJ "State Team" by scoring among the top 10 NJ Residents in .22 caliber NMC!



Glenn Bowman won place awards in .22 and .45 slow fire among the 33 Experts. **Ed Glidden** won a place award in .22 rapid fire and got his first 6 "DR" points in the Distinguished Revolver match!

Al Schneider also took an EX class place award in centerfire slow fire. Sharpshooter **Adam Storch** won place awards in both .22 timed and rapid fire, and he and
