For members who have sent in their 2010 dues, you will be receiving your 2010 membership ID Badges within the next few weeks.

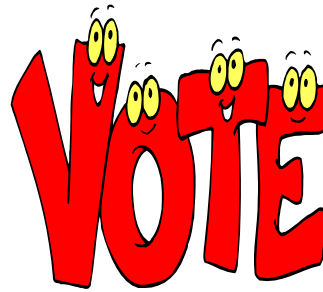
If you paid your dues and you do not receive a new badge by February 15th, please contact Rich Grubel to confirm your information.

Since my retirement, I have worked for Wackenhut Security and Assets Protection Associates as an armed security officer and currently I work as a military training contractor for the armed forces at Fort Dix and Lakehurst Naval Base where I participate in

military training exercises that train ground forces just prior to their deployment to Iraq or Afghanistan.

I have been an annual member of the National Rifle Association since 1974. I have been a member of the Old Bridge Rifle and Pistol Club since 2005. During this time I have been an active participant in various Club league events that include USPSA/IPSC, Static Steel, Knockdown Steel and PPC. As a qualified and certified instructor, I was recently authorized by the New Jersey State Police to conduct bi-annual qualifications at the Old Bridge Rifle and Pistol Club for retired police officers who want to secure or maintain their Retired Police Officers Handgun Carry Permit.

Retired Sergeant Major with over 36 years of service in the Army (both Active and Reserve). Worked for over 35 years in chemical manufacturing in supervisory and management positions of increasing responsibility. Made a mid-life career change and currently work as a Systems Analyst for a global consumer products company.

Competitive shooting experience includes: Member and coach of the All-Reserve Service Rifle team for over 20 years, five time New Jersey State Highpower Rifle Champion, Distinguished Rifleman, Presidents Hundred and hold a High Master Classification in High Power Rifle. Participate in the Shotgun, Bullseye

Pistol, Rimfire Action, Static Steel and PPC leagues sponsored by the club.

My background and experience in the military was heavily involved in marksmanship training. Starting out as an instructor and culminating in becoming the Sergeant Major of a newly formed unit that was charged with developing a cost effective way of training Army Reserve soldiers in marksmanship. This was accomplished using a laser based marksmanship training system that allowed soldiers to train using their assigned weapons, at their reserve center, before going to a range to qualify with live ammunition.

My civilian experience involved working in positions of increasing responsibility, supervising and managing work groups. I was involved in forecasting, budgeting, planning and developing, then executing, capital improvement projects. These were small to large projects, ranging from a few thousand to over three million dollars.

I have been working with the Membership Chairman to develop an automated membership database so the club can better manage its rapidly growing membership.

I worked in both large and small organizations and believe the experience and knowledge I have gained from both my civilian and military backgrounds have undoubtedly trained and qualified me to lend considerable expertise to the board of trustees for the Old Bridge Rifle and Pistol Club.

Federal Gun Bill—HR45

Letter from member Ron Saracino was sent to me for publication regarding a federal bill number HR-45.

This bill is called the—

Blair Holt's Firearm Licensing and Record of Sale Act of 2009 (Introduced in House).

This bill is very scary in that it is a Federally based bill that provides for the implementation of a system of licensing for purchasers of certain firearms and for a record of sale system for those firearms, and for other purposes.

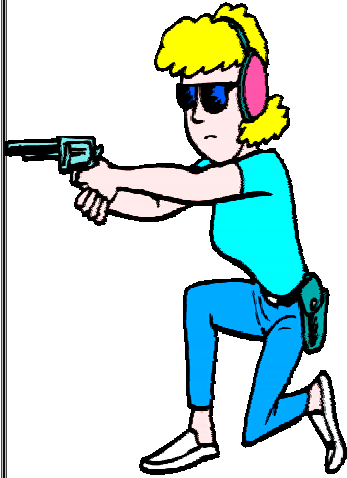
It also forbids any persons under the age of 18 to even handle a firearm. Should adults be caught working with a person under 18, they would be subject to mandatory jail time of 5 years and forfeit their right to ever own or handle a firearm again.

If this bill makes it to a vote and is passed, all gun owners across the country are in for a very rough ride. We all should contact our representative urging them to kill this bill. We can not afford to allow this one to be passed.
