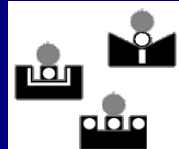

League Reports



Speed on Steel - Indoor Frangible Static Steel - This will be shot the first Sunday of each month December thru March.

Special Notice— Since the first Sunday of January is New Years Day, the January match will be moved to the first Saturday, January 7th. Check monthly club calendar for exact dates. This course of fire is shot at the INDOOR range using frangible ammunition at steel plates with some as close as 3 yards away.

We shoot at five targets on each of four stages and each stage is shot four times, so the minimum round count is 80. For individuals new to steel shooting, this is a great way to learn how to shoot steel plates. For those who have shot steel before, it is a great way to hone those skills and to practice in a warm, dry, comfortable environment during the winter when the weather is too cold to shoot outdoors.

Note: only frangible pistol caliber ammunition (i.e.- 9mm. .38Spl, .40 S&W, .45ACP) approved by the Match Director is allowed to be fired in these matches. The correct frangible ammunition (9mm., & .45ACP) will be available for purchase at just about cost at the range the day of the match.

Special Announcement — The normal Speed on Steel Match will not be held on the first Sunday of February. Instead that weekend there will be a special match being held at the indoor range. A Rimfire only Speed on Steel Invitational match will be held on Saturday and Sunday, February 4th and 5th. The course of fire will require each shooter to shot BOTH a .22LR pistol and .22LR carbine.

Sunday Steel —Conducted on the third Sunday of every month throughout the year, weather permitting. We shoot steel plates on stages of various designs and configurations (five strings of five shots each, only four fastest times count) but we do not use the “standard” World Class steel stages. Shotgun League—The Shotgun league is happy to report there are a lot of new faces at our Sunday events. Even better news for the league is many of these new faces are becoming Shotgun “Regulars”. Many have discovered that sporting clays is as fun as it is addictive. Just a reminder for everyone in the club that Shotgun is year round. We will be at the outdoor all winter long. Brave the cold and come out and join us.

November saw two exciting Turkey Shoots, where the high score walked away with a frozen turkey. The event on November 6th saw a tie between Mike B and Gary B with 44 out of 50. For the tie breaker both took 5 pairs of birds from the teal. Mike B got 9 out of 10, Gary edged him out by breaking all ten! Our event on November 20th saw a repeat performance by Gary B, winning the day again with an even more impressive 46/50. The turkey was awarded to Jim K with an equally impressive 45/50. Both men reported the turkeys as delicious.

Four our first shoot in December Gary B took the win with an superb score of 47/50. Gary M took second with 44/50, and Jim Knight and Tom B tied for third just one bird behind Gary M with 43/50.

The Shotgun League meets on the first and third Sundays every month at 9 am. Ten bucks (\$20 for non-members) buys you a round of 50 birds. The Shotgun league is beginner friendly and more importantly a lot of fun. All you need to bring is a gun you are familiar with and 50 shells of #7.5 or #8 birdshot. Pumps, Semi-Autos, and Double Barrels are all welcome, from .410 to 12 gauge. All club safety rules and common sense gun handling applies, so please know your shotgun!



World Class Steel Challenge— This league does not shoot in the winter months. It will start up in April. This league uses only official stages of the Steel Challenge are used.



Action Steel— This league is not shot during the winter months. It will start again in April. Check the club calendar for the outdoor range for dates. Pistols, pistol caliber carbine, rimfire carbine or shotgun can be used.



OBRAMS—This league does not shoot in the winter months. It will start again in April. We shoot action type stages using .22LR caliber pistols and carbines with courses of fire that are challenging and fun. together. Awards will be given for the winners of each division, (juniors & seniors). I will give you the names of the winners next month, as this was submitted prior to the event.

RANKINGS: A new list of rankings will be posted in the February newsletter.

FUNDAMENTALS: We would like to take a second to remind all of our YSB youth shooters (and everybody who shoots for that matter), of a few points:

→ "The most important shot is this one". The last shot is gone and you can't change it. The next one isn't here yet, so don't worry about it. Concentrate on the shot you are about to make. Put all you have learned into making it the best shot possible.

→ When setting up to make that shot, always remember the FIVE FUNDAMENTALS of rifle shooting:

1) **AIMING:** Adjust your body and your NPA (natural point of aim), to get your sight alignment and picture as best as possible.

2) **BREATH CONTROL:** Control your breathing to eliminate as much deviation from your aim and hold as possible.

3) **HOLD CONTROL:** The more you practice, the smaller your hold should become. Keep that shot lined up and continue to make the shot. If you feel it won't hit its mark, release and start the process over.

4) **TRIGGER CONTROL:** A nice slow gradual squeeze on the trigger, keeping all of the above in place. Try to make the shot go off while your hold is in the bull or 10 ring.

5) **FOLLOW THROUGH:** Follow through helps eliminate jerking. Having good follow through also means that you are doing nothing to disturb the shot *before, during, and after* it leaves the barrel. After the shot, continue looking through the sight to see that you are still lined up with the 10 ring (or bull). Keeping all of this in mind will help you see improvement in your scores.

DETAILS: We would like to remind everyone that we meet every Thursday of the month, except the first Thursday (general membership meeting), from 6:00pm until 9:30pm. If anyone is interested, bring your children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews down to visit. The emphasis is on safety, but our goal is to have fun and to learn the various aspects of small bore rifle shooting. From first timers to accomplished shooters, and everyone in between, they will have a good time. If you're interested or have any questions, contact me, Rich Ruff. My number is listed elsewhere in this newsletter. Until next month, shoot safely, and remember: Squeeze. Don't pull.

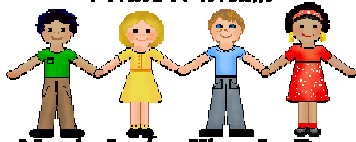
