Safety Tip Of the Month:

The Big 3

The NRA Three Rules of Safe Firearms Handling

1. Always keep the Firearm Pointed in a Safe Direction
2. Keep your finger off the Trigger until you are ready to shoot
3. Keep the firearm unloaded until you are ready to shoot

If we all remember to follow these 3 simple rules, we will all be conducting ours firearms handling in a safe and responsible manor

Shotgun league Shooters:

Effective – starting in June for shotgun shooters that come to the match on the 1st and 3rd Sunday, You will be required the participants to do the following as part of the general functioning of the league:

work throwers, keep score, pickup the empty shotgun shells, and help set up and take down the throwers.

What we are requesting is that people do not just show up, shoot and leave the break down of the leagues equipment to the same folks. If you want to leave before the match is over, you may do so, however during the match we are asking each of the participants to assist in keeping score, working the throwers, or picking up the empty shells. **NO EXCEPTIONS OR EXCUSES.**

This request is being made at request of both the Executive Board and the Shotgun League chairmen.

The Board is trying to run the club in the most efficient cost effective manors. So the Executive Board has requested that Work Hours only be given to people who assist the leagues with tasks “outside” the normal running of the match. Web Site Info—How To Log Into The Site

It’s been a few months since we’ve updated everyone on some of the web sites facility, so for our members who have joined since our last update, here is a little “refresher” on how to log onto the clubs web site.

First—our site can be reached from either one of the following two links:

**www.obrpc.org or
www.oldbridgerifle.com**

Once you are on the clubs site, you will see a blue bar that lists all the areas of the web site: events, disciplines, newsletter, etc....all the way to the right you will see the word “login”. Click on that link and you will be directed to the Login page. Just fill in your user_name and your password. If it is your first time logging into the site, we wanted to remind you of what your default ID/user_name is:

It is the first 4 letters of your last name (with the first letter capitalized) and the first two letter of your first name, again with the first letter capitalized.... So if your name was John Smith, your login ID would be SmitJo

Your default password is your membership ID.

Once you are on the site you have the option of changing both your ID and password. If you have supplied the club with an email address and you can not remember what your ID is in the “forgot your user ID or password” box, just below the login area and click on “click here” and you will see a page that asks you for your membership number and your email address. Fill that info and your login details will be sent to you via email.

For our new members who join, we try to get that person’s ID setup within 30 days of them joining. I

Combative Carbine Skills 1, 4hr

Combative Carbine Skills 1 is the MDTs entry level carbine course. In this 4 hr. module of instruction fundamental skill sets will be presented and then drilled dry fire and live fire. Course content will include but is not limited to history & zero, modifications & sling options, administrative gun-handling, carbine ready positions, fundamental marksmanship, combative marksmanship, shooting response theory, combative gun-handling/malfunctions, bilateral weapon operation, after action assessment concept and more...

Combative Carbine Skills 2, 4hrs

Combative Carbine Skills 2 picks up where CCS1 leaves off building upon fundamental skill sets while increasing tempo and aggressiveness. Previously learned skills are refined and intermediate to advanced gun-handling skills are introduced. Course content will include but is not limited to combative shooting positions, lateral displacement, proactive & reactive movement, weapon transitions, utilizing cover & concealment and more...
