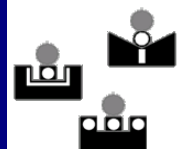

**Use of Indoor Range target frames**—Only use ONE target on a target frame. The target is to be centered on the cardboard and hung at shoulder height.

**Reminder**—All members AND their guests are to sign the log book when they come to the indoor range. This is for their protection. It provides a record that they were at the range which is a legitimate stop in NJ when transporting a firearm. The keycard swipe does not provide this unless each person was to swipe and guests would not be recorded at all.

**Earning Workhours**—The monthly Indoor and Outdoor work parties are canceled. Individuals will be contacted to

perform certain tasks autonomously on an ongoing basis as opposed to a large group on a once a month basis.

We need people to clean around the indoor range, do target replacement/repair, outdoor range maintenance and other tasks. **Bullseye Youth League**—We shoot on the 2nd and 3rd Sundays of the month at the indoor range.

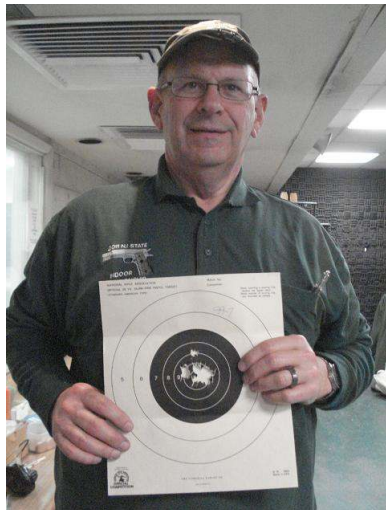

## NJ Indoor Pistol Championship at Old Bridge

Eighty competitors from across NJ, NY, PA, MD and DE competed in the March 18-20 New Jersey Indoor State Pistol Championship, hosted by Riverdale Pistol Club and OBRPC.

The winner was NJ High Master Dave Lange with 2663-140X (of a possible 2700). John Gemmill was top Grand Senior and 5th overall, claiming HM place awards including 1st in .22 Timed Fire with 199-13X.

- Ed Glidden took 4th among 18 Experts with 2534-68X. His 99-7X Slow Fire in the Centerfire match was a “personal best.”
- Al Schneider took 3 EX class place awards with the “big gun”.
- Frank Greco finished 5th among 18 Sharpshooters, firing 2358-35X, with “personal bests” in centerfire and .45 using his first reloads.
- Adam Storch took 1st in .22 Gallery with 285-8X.
- Among 26 Marksmen, Lee Mergentime finished 3rd with 2204-32X.
- Joseph Storch fired a “personal best” 832-26X for 1st place in .22 aggregate (and topping most Sharpshooters, too).
- Bill Nolan won a place award with 154-2X in .45 Slow Fire.

Other MK competitors included Bernie Wilm and Anna Storch, both firing their first 25 yard match.

PPC has become quite popular! Two months after the Annual Eat-N-Shoot we still needed (7) Relays to get all of the fun in, which shows an increased interest in our league! From Seniors to Juniors everybody is having a fun time and showing improvement from month-to-month! Here's the latest results:

The battle for Match Winner is now between the .22-Open division participants. This month's Match Winner is Frank Greco with a 575x600 followed by Jim Halbert with a 531 and Frank's son Dominic with a 358. The .22-Iron division was lead by Joe Girardi with a 498 personal- best, followed by Dean Adinolfi with a 462 personal-best, Bob Francisco with a 418 and Marianne Daly with a 413. Auto-Iron division was lead by Tom Schmidt with a personal- best 448, followed by Anthony Tomasso with a 439 and Ron Rembish with a 436. Joe Giunta netted a 402, James Heitz scored a 394, Grant Gallagher & Akin Sangiray both got 387, Nicolai Greco shot a 368, Alex Lasher a 343 and Christine Francisco did-in the big guy target with a 222. Jim Halbert also netted a 492 in Auto-Open as well as a 468 in Revolver-Open (Jim shot all three Open divisions), while Rich Skolsky hammered-out a 528 winning the Revolver- Open division. Dave Rosenthal lead the Revolver-Iron division with a 534, followed by Robert Simansky with a personal-best 496, Mike Levendusky with a 494, Tony Oliveira with a 452, Ed Bradley Jr. with a 449, new member Pete Luccarelli with a 364 and Lance Brunner with a 361.

PPC is beginner-friendly, offers an opportunity to get better accustomed to drawing a loaded sidearm from a holster while engaging B-27 & B-34 silhouettes from 7-25 yards, has a relatively low round-count (60 per Relay) and takes only about 45 minutes to shoot & score. Standing, sitting, and prone positions (as well as weak & strong-hand only drills) are utilized with limited movement so shooting our match gives you skill sets which you then take with you to other disciplines.

Next Match is Friday May 13th. I'll be away attending my son's college graduation. Mike Cinaro & Mike Levendusky may also be working, but fear not, as Frank Greco, Tony Oliveira, Rich Skolsky and others have stepped-up and volunteered to run the Match that night so we'll have one even though I won't be there! Thanks guys for stepping-up! The league and the club are better for it! Come to the May 13th Match and ask the guys how you can help and remember to bring some patience too! See you all at our June Match! Till then, keep 'em in the black!

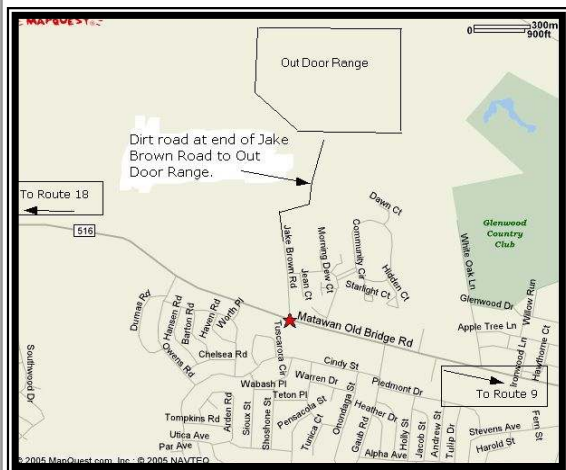

### **The Model 1855 Springfield Rifle**

One hundred and fifty years ago this month, Americans were getting ready to fight The Civil War. Both sides used this rifle, making it one of the most common shoulder weapons of the war.

The 1855 Springfield was a state-of-the-art, .58 caliber musket with a rifled barrel. Known as a "rifle musket" the Model 1855 replaced an earlier .69 caliber musket and a .54 caliber rifle. It featured improvements that increased both range and accuracy.

To achieve these increases, the Springfield Armory selected the rifling system designed by French Army Captain Claude Minié. In muskets, a round ball would closely, but not exactly, fit a barrel. For a rifled gun to work, the projectile and barrel needed to have zero-tolerance, so that the grooves on the rifle would spin the projectile as it left the gun. This spinning action would keep the bullet on a straight line in relation to the target. To ease loading the Springfield used a cylindrical-cone, hollow-based Minié Ball which would expand on firing to use the rifling on the barrel. The spin also increased the distance a projectile traveled.
