Personal Conduct: – OK—not that we want OBRPC to be totally “PC” or anything, however when it comes to personal conduct we ask that all members show respect in both action and language to fellow members. We have a number of young people involved in the club now and we’d like to set a good example for them by conducting ourselves in a respectful manor.

Safety Tip Of the Month:

Open shooting cases: Please, Case and Uncase your firearms at the firing line ONLY.

When at the Indoor range, please do not Uncase your firearms on the tables that are along the back wall of the range, only Uncase and Case them at the firing line.

Also no “handling” of the firearm may be done unless the line is “Hot” or permission from the acting Range Officer has been given to handle your firearm. When you are on the range by yourself, the same rule applies—you are acting as your own range officer - so still follow the rules

Be Safe—Do Not Handle any firearms forward of the designate firing line.

Indoor Range Target Stands

For those of our members who use the indoor range, you will note that the 25 yard stands are now stored behind the firing line. This is to prevent the stands from being shot when people are using the shorter distance stands. Please bring all the 25 yard stands back behind the firing line when you are finished with them.

And as always, you should be aware of your “Cone of Fire” when on any range. Your

targets should always be setup properly so as to keep your shots within the frame of the stand you are using.

Ladies Day at the Range

Ladies Day at the Range will be held on Saturday May 22nd. We will be hosting 4 disciplines—Shot gun, PPC, Steel and Blackpowder. We also hope to hold an optional High Power session in the afternoon.

**NJ Indoor State Pistol Championship –
Mar. 20-21, 2010**

Forty-nine competitors from 4 states, including 12 Old Bridge members, participated in our March Bullseye 2700, which was actually part of the NJ Indoor State Championship, the balance of the event being hosted this year by Riverdale. The overall NJ Champion was High Master Dave Lange, with a score of 2626-105X (of a possible 2700!)

Top Old Bridge shooter and Top NJ Senior was High Master **Kevin Ball**. Former OBRPC Trustee **Jean Verrier** claimed the top spot in the new Grand Senior category (and saved the day by performing emergency turning target repair in mid-match!)

Top OB Expert was **Ed Glidden**, who fired a “personal best” 2546-76X, including 858-24X in .22 aggregate! Ed was actually 3rd EX and would have been High NJ Resident, if not for Bruce Piatt “discovering” Bullseye this year! (Yes, *THAT* Bruce Piatt – 5 time Bianchi Cup winner!!!)

Al Schneider won a place award in .45 slow fire, and **Tim Busse** fired an outstanding first indoor 2700 in Expert class!

OB Junior league star, **Kimberly Hullings**, was High Junior for the 3rd year in a row! Among her 5



Sharpshooter class place awards was a finishing 188-5X in .45 rapid fire, for an overall grand aggregate of 2319-45X!

Sharpshooter **Adam Storch** also fired his place award winning 194-6X in .22 rapid fire (of course!)



James Halbert was 2nd of 27 Marksman with “PR” grand aggregate 2305-32X, capturing 13 place awards, including 1st in .22 rapid fire (and he uses revolvers for centerfire and .45!) **Paul Bredus** took 3rd MK with 2296-30X! Among his 7 place awards was 1st in .45 rapid fire! **Isabelita Perez** won 1st in .45 slow fire! **Joseph Storch**, age 16, had a place award in centerfire timed fire (after he tightened his red dot!)
