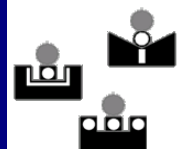

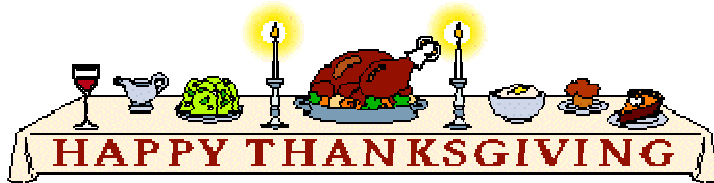

Speed on Steel - Indoor Frangible Static Steel - Starts on Sunday, December 4th. This will be shot the first Sunday of each month December thru March. Check monthly club calendar for exact dates. This course of fire is

shot at the INDOOR range using frangible ammunition at steel plates with some as close as 3 yards away.

We shoot at five targets on each of four stages and each stage is shot four times, so the minimum round count is 80. For individuals new to steel shooting, this is a great way to learn how to shoot steel plates. For those who have shot steel before, it is a great way to hone those skills and to practice in a warm, dry, comfortable environment during the winter when the weather is too cold to shoot outdoors.

Note: only frangible pistol caliber ammunition (i.e.- 9mm. .38Spl, .40 S&W, .45ACP) approved by the Match Director is allowed to be fired in these matches. The correct frangible ammunition (9mm., & .45ACP) will be available for purchase at just about cost at the range the day of the match.

The Safe Table



This month's Safe Table topic is not directly related to firearms or range safety. But it is of importance if someone is on the range with you and they have a heart attack. Knowing this procedure could save their life.

This is an easy procedure to learn and do.

Subj: New Continuous Chest Compression Procedure for Victim's of a Heart Attack

This is a relatively new procedure for assisting ADULT individuals who are experiencing a heart attack. NO CERTIFICATION, NO MOUTH TO MOUTH REQUIRED. The important thing is to do it quickly! For every minute of delay you decrease the survival chance by 10%. This short video shows exactly what to do if someone near you collapses and is presumably having a heart attack.

OBRAMS 1st ANNUAL MULTI-GUN RIMFIRE ACTION MATCH

OBRAMS concluded its shooting season on October 15th, 2011, with its first ever Multi-Gun Rimfire Action Match. In this event competitors used two Rimfire firearms (carbine and pistol) to engage numerous targets as they maneuvered around six courses of fire to include one in which the competitors shot off of a simulated roof. The targets in these six stages included traditional USPSA targets, as well as some new reactive targets such as dueling trees, a swinging silhouette, mini-clay birds and hanging "gong" type steel.



This year's competitors ranged from beginner to experienced action shooters (as well as everything in between). The stages, with names like "Make it back to the Rifle", "Pistol Samoan", "Deceptive Dueling", "Finally a Swinger", "Box It", and "Voting From the Rooftops" put their shooting abilities to the test. As with most Multi-Gun events, the competitors were divided into three classes, which were: Limited, (rifle iron, pistol iron), Tactical, (rifle optic, pistol iron), and Open, (rifle optic, pistol optic). In this manner competitors compete against shooters using the same type of equipment to determine their shooting ability. Winners for each class were: Open—Rich Ruff, Limited—Jim Heitz, Tactical—Matt Goldrick. Congratulations to all.

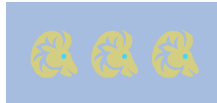

Old Bridge Bullseye Shooters Excel at 2011 NJ Outdoor State Pistol Championship

John Gemmill, Kevin Ball, Ed Glidden, Glenn Bowman, Frank Greco, Al Schneider, Adam Storch, Paul Bredus, Alex Tsapp, Bill Nolan, and Bernie Wilm all participated in the 2011 NJ Outdoor Pistol Championship, September 17th, 23rd-24th and October 1st, along with our OB junior “graduates” **Joseph Storch** and **Kimberly Hullings** who came home from college to shoot the match. Kim got a ride all the way from Ohio with our old friend, **Tim Busse**, who brought his son, **Carl**, to shoot his first .22 “900” match with us as well!

Particular award highlights include:



Kevin Ball won 7 place awards in Master class, including 1st in .22 Aggregate with 871-40X, finishing with 2590-87X for top NJ Resident Senior honors!

Glenn Bowman took 4 place awards and broke 2500, his best OD Championship aggregate in as many years as I can count!

Frank Greco also broke 2500! His “personal best” 866-30X .45 Aggregate included 188-5X .45 Slow fire (fueled by Mary’s perogies at lunch), 1st place among 32 Experts (and topped most Masters, too! Remember, this is his first year in this sport!)

Al Schneider took awards in .22 Timed fire and CF Rapid fire!

Adam Storch had an outdoor “personal best” 799-15X in CF Aggregate, finishing with a “PR” 2410-39X (I think that’s his first time breaking 2400 outdoors?!)

Paul Bredus also broke 2400 for the first time, winning the title of High NJ Resident Marksman with 2417-38X, just missing the overall class win by 2 points! His *thirteen* place awards included 1st in CF Aggregate 803-16X (he was the only MK to break 800 with all three guns!)

John Gemmill, despite injury, won 2 place awards and “cleaned it” 3 times in the .22 match!

Ed Glidden had an open win in .22 Timed Fire – his 200-10X topped all 98 competitors! Ed also won the drawing for a pistol prize among DR match participants!



Joseph Storch was 6th MK overall with 2286-24X!

Bill Nolan fired his “personal best” 2209-24X, with all three guns over 700, and won a 1st place among the 32 Marksmen in CF Rapid Fire (179-4X!)

Bernie Wilm fired his first full 2700 finishing with a wonderful 2162-32X (despite being cross-fired upon repeatedly!) His 6th place 815-12X .22 Aggregate included 1st in .22 Timed Fire (194-3X) and he even won place award money in .45 Slow Fire with that new Les Baer!



Kimberly Hullings, in her farewell appearance as a Junior in NJ, earned both titles as High NJ Resident Junior and High Woman with a “personal best” 2438-53X! She even won a sacajawea for 100-5X in .22 Timed Fire, and finished the day with her first 800+ aggregate with .45 (809-22X “PR!”)

In 1998 there were only SIX competitors in NJ’s Outdoor State Pistol Championship – the match has grown to be repeatedly among the largest outdoor Bullseye matches in the entire country thanks most primarily due to the efforts of our own **John Gemmill**, and with the help of other OBRPC club members, especially **Ed Glidden** who has also become completely indispensable in running all our matches!
