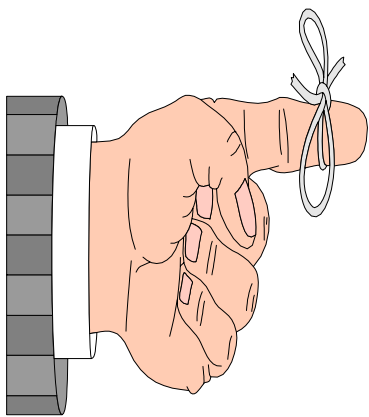

November 7th, 2009 Carbine Skills Course.

On November 7th, there will be a Carbine Skills Course hosted at the outdoor range starting at 9:00 AM and running till approx 5:00 PM.

The class will include the following set of Skills:

Carbine Skills 1, 4hr

The Skills 1 is the MDTTS entry level carbine course. This is the entry level carbine course. In this 4 hr. module of instruction fundamental skill sets will be presented and then drilled dry fire and live fire. Course content will include but is not limited to history & zero, modifications & sling options, administrative gun-handling, carbine ready positions, fundamental marksmanship, combative marksmanship, shooting responses, combative gunhandling/ malfunctions, bilateral weapon operation, after action assessments and more...

Carbine Skills 2, 4hrs

CS2 picks up where CS1 leaves off building upon fundamental skill sets while increasing tempo and aggressiveness. Previously learned skills are refined and intermediate to advanced gun-handling skills are introduced. Course content will include but is not limited to combative shooting positions, vertical and lateral displacement, proactive & reactive movement, weapon transitions

Equipment:

A serviceable carbine to include M4, AR15, AK47 or pistol caliber carbine, a minimum of 3 magazines, 500 rounds rifle and 50 rounds of pistol ammunition, eye and ear protection, pistol and one extra magazine (if you own a pistol), appropriate clothing for weather, water, hat with brim, optional equipment- sling, load bearing vest, duty gear, gloves & knee pads. This will be a very full day of training and a bag lunch is a good idea.

*A pistol is not required to attend this course

**This is an active class and students will be subject to mild to moderate physical activity, so be prepared. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.
