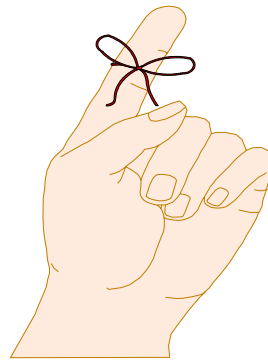
ANNOUNCING - Newsletter Editor Change

Safety Tip Of the Month

Please remember when ever you are shooting, to keep the firearm pointed in a safe direction should you experience a “Miss Fire”. There are times when a round may go off correctly. This is especially true in the case of Black powder / Muzzle loader type firearms.

So you should keep the firearm on target for a minimum of 30 seconds before bringing the firearm back down to the ready position.

You should then work to ascertain the issue and correct it as quickly and safely as possible.
