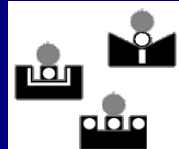

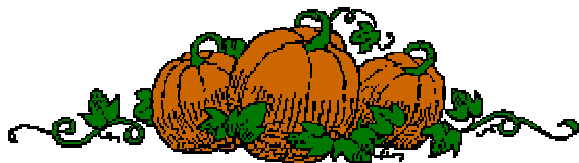

Match winner Frank Greco's 587x600 in .22 Open division, with his son Nicolai close behind with a 574! Other personal-bests were Barry Blecher with a 543 in .22 Open, Henry Mertens with a 476 in Auto-iron, Jim Neto with a 364 (Auto-iron), Lance Brunner with a 389 in Revolver-iron, Christine Francisco with a 388 (Auto-iron), Dave Cobb with a 385 (Auto-iron), and Bob Francisco with a 484 in .22-Iron. Frank's younger son Dominic rounded out our Juniors for the evening with a tally of 423 in .22 Open. Congrats to all of our shooters earning a personal-best! All of the practice & concentration seemed to have paid-off dividends.

In yet another foray into uncharted territory, League members Christine Francisco, Marianne Daly, Frank Greco and Anthony Tomasso have decided it's time to celebrate the new Fall season with a Pot-Luck Supper to be held in conjunction with our October 14th regular Match! So get out your best recipes and bring a covered dish, salad or dessert for all to share. We may even have a judging of the delectable goodies and post the results of same in the newsletter! So what would YOU like to bring? Give all of our Supper Committee members an email with your ideas so that they can better coordinate this Extravaganza!

Now back to our regular programming, LOL! As you can see, PPC League is a FUN place to be as well as an excellent venue to learn the basics of safe gun handling in a friendly competitive atmosphere. We feature a 60-round Course of Fire shooting in free-style standing, barricade, sitting and prone positions while engaging B-27 & B-34 silhouette targets from 7-25 yards distance. Side arms can be holstered or you may start from the low-ready position. Each Relay takes approx. 45 minutes to shoot & score. First timers are welcome and are asked to attend at least one Relay prior to shooting our League so that they may better acquaint themselves with the Range Commands and cadence. All that's required is a hand gun that you're completely familiar with, 4 mags or speed-loaders, 60 rounds per Relay you wish to shoot, and a zippered gun rug or hard case to carry the hand gun to the firing line. As mentioned before, holsters are used, but you can start from the low-ready position. Extra supplies & equipment are always available every League night, so don't be afraid to

ask for a loaner mag or even a holster or ammo if you forgot yours. We want you to have a safe, fun time at our League! Hoping to see all of you at our Pot Luck Supper Match on the 14th! We will have a start time of 6:00 pm for Supper, so we can get-in as many Relays as you folks wish to shoot! Please plan accordingly!

OBRAMS—We shoot action type stages using .22LR caliber pistols and carbines. You only need to bring a pistol or carbine, at least 4 magazines, ammunition, eye and ear protection and the expectation to have a good time. No other equipment is required. No holsters, no belts, no mag pouches, nothing else. The courses of fire are challenging and fun. Check out www.OBRAMS.org for more information and updates. The Safe Table

NRA Gun Safety Rules

The fundamental NRA rules for safe gun handling are:



1. ALWAYS keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.

This is the primary rule of gun safety. A safe direction means that the gun is pointed so that even if it were to go off it would not cause injury or damage. The key to this rule is to control where the muzzle or front end of the barrel is pointed at all

times. Common sense dictates the safest direction, depending on different circumstances.



2. ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot. When holding a gun, rest your finger on the trigger guard or along the side of the gun. Until you are actually ready to fire, do not touch the trigger.



3. ALWAYS keep the gun unloaded until ready to use.

Whenever you pick up a gun, immediately engage the safety device if possible, and, if the gun has a magazine, remove



it before opening the action and looking into the chamber(s) which should be clear of ammunition. If you do not know how to open the action or inspect the chamber(s), leave the gun alone and get help from someone who does.

When using a gun, always follow these NRA rules:

Know your target and what is beyond. Be absolutely sure you have identified your target beyond any doubt. Equally important, be aware of the area beyond your target. This means observing your prospective area of fire before you shoot. Never fire in a direction in which there are people or any other potential for mishap. Think first. Shoot second.

Know how to use the gun safely. Before handling a gun, learn how it operates. Know its basic parts, how to safely open and close the action and remove any ammunition from the gun or magazine. Remember, a gun's mechanical safety device is never foolproof. Nothing can ever replace safe gun handling.

Be sure the gun is safe to operate. Just like other tools, guns need regular maintenance to remain operable. Regular cleaning and proper storage are a part of the gun's general upkeep. If there is any question concerning a gun's ability to function, a knowledgeable gunsmith should look at it.

Use only the correct ammunition for your gun. Only BBs, pellets, cartridges or shells designed for a particular gun can be fired safely in that gun. Most guns have the ammunition type stamped on the barrel. Ammunition can be identified by information printed on the box and sometimes stamped on the cartridge. Do not shoot the gun unless you know you have the proper ammunition.

Wear eye and ear protection as appropriate. Guns are loud and the noise can cause hearing damage. They can also emit debris and hot gas that could cause eye injury. For these reasons, shooting glasses and hearing protectors should be worn by shooters and spectators.

Never use alcohol or over-the-counter, prescription or other drugs before or while shooting. Alcohol, as well as any other substance likely to impair normal mental or physical bodily functions, must not be used before or while handling or shooting guns.

Be aware that certain types of guns and many shooting activities require additional safety precautions.
